

INSTITUTIONAL LICENSE AGREEMENT

Any Institution that subscribes to the Sociometrics Social Science Electronic Data Library must abide by the terms of this Institutional License Agreement. The Agreement allows for unlimited access of the Data Library to the Subscriber Institution's faculty, students, and staff only. The contents of the Data Library may not be copied except for permitted educational and scientific research use as specified in #8 below. The Subscriber Institution is responsible for the acts of its employees, agents, and others to whom it allows access. All users of the Data Library must be informed regarding the terms or the License Agreement.

Sociometrics Corporation, 170 State Street, Suite 260, Los Altos, CA 94022 ("Sociometrics") grants the Subscriber Institution (Name of Subscriber Institution _____) the right to use the Sociometrics Social Science Electronic Data Library (the "Product") in the manner provided herein for the subscription period expiring on _____. This License Agreement imposes significant restrictions on the use of the Product. Any use of the Product or any portion thereof not in conformance with the terms of this License Agreement constitutes a violation of this License Agreement and may result in civil liability. Occasionally, customized license agreements can be negotiated.

1. Proprietary Information Notice. The material contained in the Product was prepared for use by Sociometrics and its collaborators. The Product contains information proprietary to Sociometrics and may not be published, copied or quoted (in whole or in part) without specific written approval of Sociometrics, except as provided in Sections 8, 9 and 10 below.

2. Notice. The information contained in the Product is not to be used for other than the purposes for which it is furnished by Sociometrics, nor is the Product (in whole or in part) to be reproduced or furnished to third parties (other than to carry out said purposes) or made public without the prior express written permission of Sociometrics. Neither Sociometrics nor any of the contributors to the Product makes any warranty or representation (express or implied) with respect to the accuracy, completeness or usefulness of the information contained in the Product. Sociometrics assumes no responsibility for liability or damage of any kind which may result from the use of the information contained in the Product.

3. Data Use Restrictions. All individuals using Sociometrics data sets are subject to the Public Health Services Act that prohibits any effort to determine the identity of any reported case. Therefore, users will:

- a) Use Sociometrics' data for statistical reporting, analysis and teaching only,

- b) Make no use of the identity of any person or establishment discovered inadvertently; and
- c) Not link Sociometrics' data with individually identifiable data from other data sets.

4. Intellectual Property Rights. The Product is owned by Sociometrics or its suppliers and is protected by copyright law, international copyright treaty, trademark law, international trademark treaty, the law of contracts and licenses, and by other applicable law. Treat the Product like any other protected material and carefully observe and do not infringe upon the rights of Sociometrics or its suppliers.

5. Definitions. The following terms as used in this License Agreement, wheresoever used shall have the following indicated definitions:

- a) "Documentation" means the collateral materials (whether printed or supplied electronically, orally or otherwise) provided with or as a result of the purchase of the Product.
- b) "Product" shall mean the data sets, databases, Documentation, this License Agreement and all other information provided to or made available to the Subscriber Institution by Sociometrics as a result of the purchase of the Product.

6. License. Sociometrics grants the Subscriber Institution a license and right to use the Product for statistical reporting, analysis and teaching only, in conformance with the terms of this License Agreement.

7. Product Use Restrictions. Use of this Product is restricted as follows:

- a) Subscriber Institutions may not copy or allow the copying of the Product or any part thereof for any purpose except as expressly permitted in Sections 8 and 9 below;
- b) Subscriber Institutions may not use this Product or any portion thereof in a manner that violates any law or treaty, including without limitation all laws and treaties relating to copyrights, trademarks, trade secrets, patents, contracts, licenses or privacy and specifically including the Public Health Services Act or any successor law.
- c) Subscriber Institutions shall limit access to the Product and all portions of the Product to its employees, agents, and if applicable, Students (as defined in Section 8 below).
- d) Subscriber Institutions may not publish, quote, lend, rent, lease, sell, or hypothecate the Product or any part thereof or allow other persons or entities who are not employees or agents of the Subscriber Institution to do the same or otherwise use the Subscriber Institution's copy of the Product or any part thereof in any way, except as expressly permitted in Sections 8, 9 and 10 below;
- e) Subscriber Institutions must provide notice to all users of the Product regarding the terms of this License Agreement in a manner calculated to lead to an awareness in each Product user of the terms of this License Agreement.

8. Permitted Educational and Scientific Use. Notwithstanding the above, Subscriber Institution may use the Product for Educational Purposes as described in this Section. Any use not in strict compliance with this Section and not in compliance with any other Section of this License Agreement is a violation of this Agreement and may result in liability.

a) "Educational Use" means use of the product by a Teacher or Student of the Subscriber Institution in a scientific research situation, a face-to-face teaching situation or for preparation to enter into a face-to-face teaching situation.

b) A "Teacher" is an individual who is employed by or is an agent of the Subscriber Institution and whose job duties specifically include conducting scientific research or providing educational or training services to Students (defined below).

c) A "Student" is an individual who is an employee or agent of the Subscriber Institution or who is enrolled in a class which is offered by the Subscriber Institution at a public or non-profit school.

d) Multiple printed copies of dataset documentation may be made by or for a Teacher for Educational Use in the classroom, provided that all of the following limitations are fully observed and complied with:

- All copies shall be on paper in printed form - it is a violation of this License Agreement and Sociometrics' rights to copy documentation material from the Product in other than printed form;
- Only one copy may be made for each Student, and all copies made shall be distributed to Students;
- The copying is made from a copy of the Product during the active subscription term specified in an earlier section of this agreement;
- All Students receiving a copy of any portion of the Product shall be advised regarding the Data Use Restrictions (Section 3 hereof);
- All copies shall have the following printed on each page: "© Sociometrics Corporation, Los Altos, California, Use Restricted by License and Applicable Law"; and
- No charge other than a nominal charge for photocopy cost reimbursement shall be made to any Student for provision of the copy.

e) Electronic copies made of any data and associated SPSS or SAS program statement files can be downloaded to hard drives only. No copies may be made to diskette, CD-ROM, magnetic tape, or any other portable medium. Copies may not be e-mailed nor put on a server or network.

9. Additional End User Obligations and Agreements. Subscriber institutions shall, in addition to the obligations and restrictions stated above, also have the following obligations:

a) Subscriber Institutions shall immediately report to Sociometrics any violation of the terms of this or any other Sociometrics License Agreement of which they become aware;

b) Subscriber Institutions who fail to advise buyers as required in paragraph 7(d) hereof shall remain fully liable for any breaches of this License Agreement or other applicable law by any person or entity acquiring the copy of the Product originally acquired by the Subscriber Institution;

c) The Subscriber Institution agrees that it is responsible for the actions of its employees, agents and others who have access to the Subscriber Institution's copy of the Product, and

that it accepts responsibility for any violations of this License Agreement or Sociometrics' legal rights by any such person.

10. Miscellaneous Provisions. The Subscriber Institution agrees to the following terms, in addition to those terms printed above:

a) This License Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the substantive laws of the State of California and the federal laws of the United States of America.

b) This License Agreement is a complete and exclusive statement of the Subscriber Institution's rights and obligations with regard to the Product. Where a conflict exists, the terms of this License Agreement shall supersede the terms of any purchase order, business form, oral or written communications except that the Subscriber Institution's rights and obligations with regard to the Product may be altered from the terms stated herein through a writing duly signed by an authorized agent of Sociometrics which specifically refers to this License Agreement.

c) If any portion of this License Agreement is held to be illegal or unenforceable, then the remainder of this License Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
