HIV RAP is a comprehensive library of research and prevention resources assembled in a single online collection. Developed in collaboration with the National Institutes of Health, these science-based resources offer you the information you need to know about, act on, and assess effective HIV prevention programs. Specifically, HIV RAP can help you:

- Build your staff and client knowledge base about HIV/AIDS and how to prevent it (KNOW).
- Implement and culturally adapt effective HIV prevention programs (ACT).
- Determine your HIV prevention program needs/evaluate your program efforts (ASSESS).

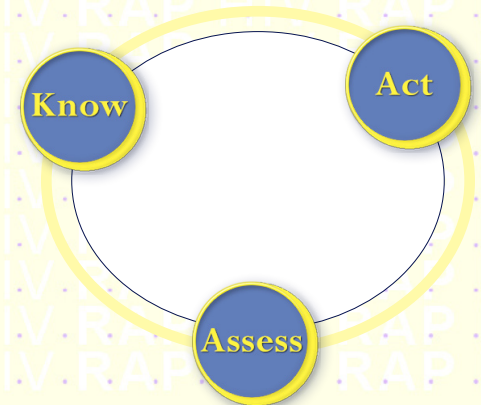

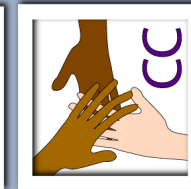

Identify and replicate an effective HIV prevention program that meets your population's specific needs. Assess effectiveness with provided evaluation instruments.

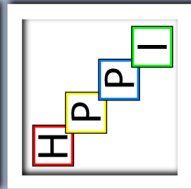
Create a positive learning environment for young African-American women using this interactive program that requires minimal staff time.

Understand culture and cultural competence and their connection to HIV. Conduct effective and culturally competent program planning, implementation, and evaluation.

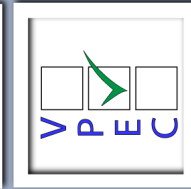
