ESTABLISHMENT OF AN AIDS/STD DATA ARCHIVE PHASE I

This project investigated the feasibility of establishing an archive of data from the best social research studies dealing with AIDS and other sexually transmitted diseases. Phase I focused on those new aspects of the project that had not yet been established as feasible and useful by previous work, such as the constitution of a National Advisory Panel; identification and description of candidate data sets and measurement instruments; and development of a mailing list for the project newsletter and catalog. Phase II funding was subsequently awarded and work continued under Sociometrics Project No. 36.
