

## **SOCIOMETRICS PROJECT No. 39**

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### **ESTABLISHMENT OF A RESEARCH ARCHIVE ON DISABILITY IN THE U.S. PHASE I**

This project investigated the feasibility of establishing an archive of the best social research data dealing with disability in the United States. Phase I focused on those new aspects of the project that had not yet been established as feasible and useful by previous work, such as the constitution of a National Advisory Panel; identification and description of candidate data sets and measurement instruments; and development of a mailing list for the project newsletter and catalog. Phase II funding was subsequently obtained (see Project No. 48).
