## ARCHIVE OF EXEMPLARY BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE RESEARCH INSTRUMENTS PHASE II & PHASE IIB

This project completed development of three related product sets built around the best-selling data sets in the Sociometrics Social Science Electronic Data Library: a printed book, a CD-ROM series, and an Internet suite.

- 1. BOOK:** *U.S. Social Surveys: Questions and Responses from National Surveys* consists of brief “chapters” covering the contents of each dataset included in the collection. The book also includes Teaching Modules for those datasets that have additional instructional materials.
- 2. CD-ROM SERIES:** A set of CD-ROMs was produced. Each CD-ROM contains a standard set of files for each dataset in the collection. Users access all files from the **Table of Contents**, which provides links to each document available for the dataset. Available documents include a Study Summary, Questionnaire, Weighted Bar Charts, Weighted Data Tables, and a Teaching Module.
- 3. INTERNET SUITE:** The Internet suite has content identical to that of the CD-ROM series. The Home page and Teaching Modules are in HTML format. The Study Summary, Questionnaire, Bar Charts, and Data Tables are in PDF format. Online searches of the BSRI Internet suite is accomplished through Verity.

The project also produced a Data and Internet Literacy Series consisting of six training modules with accompanying instructor packages:

Training Module #2: All About Data Collection

Training Module #3: Understanding Data in Numbers, Words, and Pictures

Training Module #4: Using the Internet to Find the Information You Need

Training Module #5: How to Give Your Organization an On-line Presence

Training Module #6: Using Your Internet and Data Skills to Achieve Fundraising Goals
