

TEEN PREGNANCY DATA ARCHIVES

This contract continued the work of the Data Archive on Adolescent Pregnancy and Pregnancy Prevention (DAAPPP) and the Program Archive on Sexuality, Health & Adolescence (PASHA) (see Project Nos. 1, 3, 16, 29, 41, 46, and 51). Sociometrics prepared for public use new DAAPPP data sets and/or PASHA program packages over the five-year period of performance of the contract. With the best data sets able to speak to the incidence, prevalence, antecedents, and consequences of teen sex, contraception, pregnancy and parenthood, DAAPPP is the depository of the largest and best collection of data on teen pregnancy and pregnancy prevention in the U.S. PASHA packages are prevention programs for public use that have been shown by scientific evaluation methods to be effective in preventing or reducing risky sexual behavior in at least one subgroup of teens.

Additional funding was subsequently awarded (see Project No. 156).
