REGIONAL TRAINING WORKSHOPS FOR COMMUNITY CHALLENGE GRANT AND MALE INVOLVEMENT PROGRAMS

This project entailed the provision of three workshops on “Using Teen Pregnancy Prevention Curricula Effectively” to Community Challenge Grant and Male Involvement Program grantees of the California Office of Community Challenge Grants. The workshops were a joint effort by Sociometrics Corporation and Dr. Douglas Kirby of ETR Associates. Sociometrics presented information and facilitated exercises on exemplifying characteristics common to effective curricula, identifying gaps and strengthening key characteristics in curricula, and using Sociometrics’ Program Archive on Sexuality, Health and Adolescence (PASHA) Activity Sourcebook to strengthen educational messages. In addition, Sociometrics provided individual technical assistance to participants, presented a panel responding to participant questions, and facilitated round table discussions of issues arising from the workshops.
