

SOCIOMETRICS PROJECT No. 121

VIOLENCE PREVENTION RESOURCE INVENTORY (VPRI)

The Santa Clara County Public Health Department contracted Sociometrics to collaborate on the development of a resource inventory that focused on “best practices” in violence prevention programming at the national and local levels. The resource inventory focused on the three main policy areas delineated in Santa Clara County’s 1998 *Violence Prevention Action Plan*: promoting violence-free relationships, reducing and preventing firearm-related violence, and reducing and preventing alcohol-related violence. Each area included a special emphasis on strategies to reach youth. The target audience for this resource included prevention practitioners, policy-makers, and community members.

Funds for this project were encumbered through the contract that funded Sociometrics’ work on the Santa Clara County Public Health Department’s Violence Prevention Information Library (VPIL) Project (see description of Project No. 100) and Grant Writing for the Adolescent Pregnancy Prevention Network (see description of Project No. 100a).
