### **PROMOTING SUSTAINABILITY OF A COUNTY-WIDE ADOLESCENT PREGNANCY PREVENTION PROGRAM IN SANTA CLARA COUNTY (SUPPLEMENT)**

This project complemented Sociometrics' work on Project 99, with the Adolescent Pregnancy Prevention Network (APPN) of Santa Clara County. The purposes of the project were to:

- Assess APPN's overall progress toward its established goals since the development of the *APPN Action Plan* in 1998
- Carry out needs and assets assessment and strategic planning, especially regarding reassessment of goals and objectives, youth involvement, communication and collaboration, and prioritizing training and funding needs
- Provide additional training to APPN members in key areas, such as program modeling, evaluation, best practices, youth involvement, data and Internet literacy, and grant writing
- Develop orientation materials for new APPN members
- Seek new funding for programming and institutionalization of on-going strategic planning and training.
