ASSESSMENT OF TRAINING PROGRAMS' EVALUATION INFRASTRUCTURE

Sociometrics was contracted to assess the evaluation infrastructure of seven graduate-level training programs in healthcare management funded by Johnson & Johnson (J&J) Corporate Giving. Deliverables included:

- One report on each of the seven programs that summarizes program activities and apparent areas of strength; strengths and weaknesses of the current evaluation infrastructure and procedures; and how the evaluation infrastructure and practices could potentially be expanded and improved.
- One brief final report that summarizes the strengths and weaknesses of the various programs' evaluation infrastructures, and makes cross-program suggestions for next steps with respect to information sharing and strategic planning for evaluation.
- One presentation to and meeting with J&J Corporate Contributions staff. The presentation summarized highlights of the reports; subsequent discussion focused on recommendations for next steps with respect to the sites' sharing of evaluation-related information and their evaluation infrastructure development.

The seven training programs to be assessed are based at the following locations:

- two at the University of California, Los Angeles;
- one at the University of Pennsylvania;
- one at Rutgers University (New Jersey);
- one at INSEAD (Fontainebleau, France);
- one at the Singapore Management University; and
- one at the University of Cape Town (South Africa).
