Sociometrics provided professional services on behalf of Johns Hopkins University (JHU). These services consisted of data archiving one dataset entitled “Welfare, Children, and Families: A Three City Study (Boston, Chicago, and San Antonio) Embedded Developmental Study, Wave 2, 2000-01.”

The work completed consists of the standard activities required for the data archiving of one dataset. This dataset is part of the Child Welfare and Poverty Archive, available via Sociometrics’ Social Science Electronic Data Library and Sociometrics’ individual purchasers web site. A data use agreement is required for all users of the aforementioned dataset.

Sociometrics completed the following: Preparation of the original data file(s) to create Sociometrics’ standard product file set, which includes: raw data, SPSS and SAS syntax statements, SPSS data dictionary and frequencies, SPSS portable system file, a User’s Guide to the Machine-Readable files, and PDF versions of all instruments, codebooks, and accompanying documentation. Preparation of dataset includes application of Sociometrics’ Search & Retrieval and Data Extract program for distribution of the dataset on CD-ROM. In addition, this dataset will be made part of the special edition of all JHU datasets on CD-ROM. All of the JHU datasets will include the Search & Retrieval and Data Extract program.
