

**EVALUATION SERVICES ON BEHALF OF THE JOHNSON & JOHNSON SCHOOL NURSE FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM**

This project is providing evaluation services on behalf of the Johnson & Johnson School Nurse Fellowship Program (J&J SNFP). The J&J SNFP is an annual week-long training program held at Rutgers University that provides professional education to school nurses on drug- and alcohol-related problems and other behavioral health issues among students. Each nurse's administrator must attend the program for two days; during this time, nurses and administrators examine ways to implement new prevention strategies. Sociometrics has already collaborated with J&J and Rutgers SNFP staff to develop a program model (logic model) and theory of change narrative for the J&J SNFP. Under the current project, we are continuing to work with program staff to develop outcome indicators and instruments for the program, collect and analyze outcome data, and prepare a reports on the findings.
