

PLANNING AND EVALUATION CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE COALITION FOR ALCOHOL AND DRUG FREE PREGNANCIES (CADFP)

Sociometrics Corporation provided planning and evaluation-related consulting services to the Coalition for Alcohol and Drug Free Pregnancies (CADFP) of Santa Clara County, a newly-funded collaborative effort that includes representatives of governmental and non-governmental health and social service agencies, as well as members of the public. These consulting services included:

1. Background research on best practices in preventing or intervening with alcohol, tobacco, and other drug use by pregnant women.
2. Assistance with development of needs and assets assessment instruments and interpretation of needs and assets assessment data.
3. Provision of a logic model workshop and facilitation of logic model development for CADFP's implementation effort.
4. Assistance with Institutional Review Board (IRB) application paperwork for CADFP programming and evaluation activities.
5. Assistance with intervention development, including program component planning and health education material development.
6. Assistance with evaluation indicator and instrument development.
