

EVALUATION INFRASTRUCTURE PLANNING SERVICES FOR THE GLOBAL FUND FOR CHILDREN

Sociometrics collaborated with The Vallarta Institute to provide evaluation infrastructure-related consulting services on behalf of the Global Fund for Children, a foundation that works to advance the dignity of children and youth worldwide. GFC achieves its mission through 1) small grants to community-based organizations serving the world's most vulnerable young people and 2) harnessing the power of children's books films and documentary photography to promote global understanding.

Specifically, Sociometrics Corporation and The Vallarta Institute worked with the GFC staff, President, Board of Directors Metrics Subcommittee, and other key stakeholders to:

1. Develop and refine short-term organizational development (capacity-building) outputs/outcomes, consistent with the existing draft GFC Metrics Framework for Outcomes and Impact;
2. Create an evaluation framework and implementation plan for these short-term outputs/outcomes;
3. Train staff and support a pilot implementation of the new system;
4. Develop and refine longer-term programmatic outputs/outcomes consistent with this framework; and
5. Create an evaluation framework and implementation plan for these longer-term outputs/outcomes.
