PROMOTING USE OF EFFECTIVE EARLY INTERVENTION PROGRAMS PHASE II

This project will result in the development of three interrelated products: 1) the *Early Intervention Program Archive to Reduce Developmental Disability (EIPARDD)*, which will consist of complete replication kits of all necessary materials (e.g., manuals, workbooks) to implement and evaluate empirically-supported interventions for young children with or at risk for developmental disability; 2) an online *Early Intervention Program Selection Resource* to facilitate the selection of the appropriate empirically-supported intervention program for a given need; and 3) a set of online *Early Intervention Program Implementation and Evaluation Tutorials* that offer generalized and program-tailored implementation and evaluation information to promote program fidelity and evaluation. Technical usability testing and consumer feedback will be used extensively throughout the process to ensure that all final products meet the needs of early intervention professionals. In addition, a mixed-method research study will be conducted to investigate the fidelity of implementing effective early intervention programs in new sites.
