The overall aim of the proposed project is to foster networking and strategic partnerships to advance best practice programming in adolescent pregnancy and STI/HIV prevention in Santa Cruz and Monterey counties. Specific project objectives are:

1) Phase 1 (Year 1): To investigate existing program efforts, with the goal of promoting the establishment of a network of professionals committed to adolescent pregnancy and STI/HIV prevention in new counties.

2) Phase 2 (Year 2): To pilot the implementation and evaluation of best practice teen pregnancy and STI/HIV prevention programming in new counties, with a special focus on girls' leadership.
