The Bronx Teen Connection, a program of the NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, will undertake an implementation of Teen Health Project, an evidence based intervention focused on reducing adolescent STI rates in the Bronx. Training includes content and delivery strategies for facilitators of the program as well as program oversight, evaluation and implementation training for the program's administrative staff. Additional services include technical assistance on program implementation and evaluation and consultation on adaptation and community mobilization strategies to ensure a success implementation of Teen Health Project that maintains fidelity to core elements, while providing content relevant to the adolescent populations of the Bronx.
