<a href="#"><u>Adolescents Living Safely: AIDS Awareness, Attitudes and Actions</u></a>	Runaway youths 11-18 years	20 small group discussion sessions with case management and private counseling
<a href="#"><u>Adolescents Living Safely: AIDS Awareness, Attitudes and Actions for Gay, Lesbian and Bisexual Teens</u></a>	LGBT youth ages 14-19	Provides education, social and medical services, and peer support through case management, comprehensive health care, and risk assessment counseling with small group discussion sessions
<a href="#"><u>Brother to Brother</u></a>	AA, GB men	A three-session behavioral intervention aimed at reducing HIV infection
<a href="#"><u>Focus on the Future</u></a>	AA men living with STI/HIV	A safer sex intervention for recently diagnosed individuals
<a href="#"><u>HORIZONS: STI/HIV Sexual Risk Reduction Intervention for African American Girls</u></a>	AA adolescent girls	A two-session STI/HIV sexual risk reduction program for small groups
<a href="#"><u>Hot, Healthy, and Keeping it Up!</u></a>	API, GB men	A three-hour, single session, culturally appropriate intervention
<a href="#"><u>Poder Latino: A Community AIDS Prevention Program for Inner-City Latino Youth</u></a>	HIS youth ages 14-20	A multifaceted community AIDS prevention program for high-risk inner-city youth
<a href="#"><u>Portland Women's Health Program</u></a>	Recently incarcerated women	A program of 10 one-to-one sessions with a trained health specialist to reduce HIV risk behaviors and increase life stability
<a href="#"><u>Project SAFE (P-SAFE)</u></a>	HIS women	A computer-delivered HIV/STI prevention program with videos of individual women speaking candidly about HIV/STI-related topics, skills instruction, and role-play
<a href="#"><u>Project SAFE: Sexual Awareness For Everyone An Intervention to Prevent STDs Among Minority Women</u></a>	AA, HIS women	A three session cognitive-behavioral intervention designed to reduce STIs
<a href="#"><u>Reach for Health: A School-Sponsored Community Youth Service Intervention for Middle School Students</u></a>	AA, HIS youth grades 5-8	A school-sponsored community youth service intervention for middle school students, combining a classroom teaching component with community service work
<a href="#"><u>Real Talk</u></a>	AA, GB men	A sexual health promotion program developed in response to the continued need for evidence-based HIV prevention

<a href="#">Rikers Health Advocacy Program (RHAP)</a>	Incarcerated male adolescent drug users 16- 18	Four one-hour small group sessions focusing on health education issues, particularly HIV/AIDS
<a href="#">SiHLE: Health Workshops for Young Black Women</a>	AA adolescent girls	Health workshops addressing STI/HIV/AIDS prevention needs
<a href="#">State-Wide Indian Drug Prevention Program</a>	NA youth grades 4-6	A program to prevent substance abuse among Native American and Alaskan Native youths.
<a href="#">Teen Health Project (THP): Community-Level HIV Prevention Intervention for Adolescents in Low Income Housing Development</a>	Adolescents in Low Income Housing	A community-level HIV prevention intervention
<a href="#">The SISTA Project</a>	AA women ages 18-29	A peer-led program to prevent HIV infection
<a href="#">WILLOW: HIV Transmission Reduction Among Women Living with HIV</a>	AA women living with HIV	An HIV transmission reduction group intervention
<a href="#">Youth AIDS Prevention Project (YAPP)</a>	AA youth grades 5-8	STDs, HIV/AIDS, and substance abuse prevention among high-risk students
<a href="#">Youth and AIDS Project's HIV Prevention Program</a>	GB males ages 13 - 21	Provides education, peer support, counseling, and case management to males at high risk for HIV/AIDS
